This year we will be using the Whova event app. You can download it any time between now and our event. This year we will again be providing a prize for engagement!


Monday evening, we will be having a welcome reception at the Great Dane, 123 E. Doty St. starting at 6 PM, join us if you are able.

Transportation:

A complimentary airport shuttle is available between Dane County Regional Airport and the hotel for all overnight guests from 4:30 AM to 10:30 PM.

- From the airport: Call the hotel when ready for pick-up. The shuttle picks up across the street from baggage claim Door 5. If you arrive after 11 PM, taxis are available outside Door 7. Rideshare services such as Uber and Lyft pick up at the median across from Door 5.
- From the hotel: Make a reservation at the front desk. The shuttle runs to the airport daily on the hour and half-hour during shuttle hours.
